I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to the Appeals Chamber ("Chamber") a "Request for Recusal of the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court in the Case of Venezuela I Due to Conflict of Interest", along with its corresponding attachment ("Request") as Annex I and II, received by the Court Management Section on 4 November 2024 from the Arcadia Foundation ("Submitter"), as well as three additional documents ("Documents") as Annex III, IV and V, received by the Submitter on 6 November 2024.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- 2. On 4 November 2024, the Registry received an e-mail from the Submitter with the Request.¹
- 3. On 5 November 2024, the Registry sought the Chamber's guidance in relation to how the Request should be submitted.²
- 4. In its response, the Chamber instructed the Registry to submit the request *via* a public Registry transmission filing ("Instruction").³
- 5. On 6 November 2024, the Registry requested the Submitter by e-mail to confirm the public classification of the Request.⁴
- 6. On 6 November 2024, the Registry received an e-mail from the Submitter in which they confirmed the public classification of the Request, and attached the Documents.⁵

- 8. On 7 November, the Registry received an e-mail from the Submitter in which they requested the Documents to be annexed to the Registry transmission filing along with the Request.⁷
- 9. On the same day, the Registry confirmed with the Chamber that the Documents could be annexed to the Registry transmission filing.⁸

10. The present submission before the Appeals Chamber is made on the basis of rule 34(3) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
